Diplomatic Service 1874, Attaché at Madrid 1874-76, Sec. at Constantinople:1877-79, Sec. at St. Petersburg 1879-81, Chargé d'Affaires in Bulgaria 1882-84, in Roumania 1886-88, Sec. of Legation in Persia 1888-93, Amb. Extraordinary to the Republic of Uruguay 1906-12, formerly H.M. Min. Res. at Cetinje, Montenegro, was in attendance of the Shah of Persia during his visit to England, sometime Lieut. Royal N. Down Militia, K.J.St.J., Dir.-in-Chief for Ulster St. John and British Red Cross 1915-36, Gov. of Campbell Coll., Belfast 1918-36; *b.* 24 Dec 1851, *educ.* Harrow, and Univ. Coll.
